SUMMARY POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Transporter will be responsible for the transporting of Education Department students, and preparing snacks.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Transport students home after services are received.
 2. Plans varied menus to ensure that food is appetizing and nutritionally suitable for children.
 3. Estimates and purchases daily/weekly food supplies.
 4. Responsible for maintaining, cleaning and fueling the van.
 5. Submit written monthly reports to Education Director pertaining to scope of work.
 6. Report needed repairs and safety concerns.
 7. All other duties assigned.
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QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High School diploma or GED preferred.
 2. Must possess a valid California Class C Driver's license and be insurable through the Tribe, California Class B Commercial License preferred.
 3. Must successfully clear a TB skin test.
 4. Must successfully complete pre-employment drug/alcohol screen and background investigation.
 5. Must be able to work with youth from K-12th grade.
 6. Must be professional, polite, and respectful towards all guests.
 7. Excellent interpersonal skills with demonstrated patience, tact and respect.
 8. Must be dependable and able to work flexible hours based on the departments needs.
 9. If previously employed within the Tule River Indian Tribe of California entities, you must have acceptable work history.

6. Ability to work weekends and Holidays (when needed).
7. Ability to work shifts that may exceed 8 hours (when needed).

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Position requires prolonged sitting for long periods as well as stooping, squatting, lifting, carrying, pushing and climbing in the performance of daily activities. Able to work a flexible schedule. Must be able to travel, enter, and exit a vehicle without assistance and withstand exposure to adverse weather conditions. Requires good manual dexterity (hand, hand with arm, two hands) and multi-limb coordination movement. Must be able to lift, push, pull or carry objects, use abdominal and lower back muscles to provide support over time without fatigue. Acute hearing is required. Regularly works in outside conditions that include inclement weather, heat and humidity. Frequently must be able to lift up to 10 pounds, normally must be able to lift up to 40 pounds, and occasionally must be able to lift up to 50 pounds. Noise level is generally moderate. This job will require the use of a vehicle, and an employee must be able to have those repetitive motions and coordination associated with operating a vehicle or equipment.
